

1 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.1. AIAPGET 2017 is a ranking examination for admission to AYUSH MD/MS Post Graduate courses for 2017-18 academic session.
- 1.2. Applicant may kindly note that appearance in AIAPGET 2017 does not confer any automatic rights to secure a AYUSH Post Graduate MD/MS seat. The selection and admission to Postgraduate seats in any AYUSH institutions recognized for running MD/MS Post Graduate courses as per the CCIM/CCH Act is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, medical fitness and such criteria as may be prescribed by the respective universities, AYUSH institutions, CCIM/CCH, State/Central Government.
- 1.3. Online Registration begins on 27th June 2017 from 9 am onwards and must be completed by 15th July 2017 by 4pm.
- 1.4. Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information will not be considered and candidates may be further debarred from appearing in any future examinations conducted by Ministry of AYUSH/Other institutions.
- 1.5. Before initiating registration process, candidates should go through the Information Bulletin carefully for eligibility criteria, scheme and pattern of examination etc before contacting AIIA for any queries. Queries pertaining to eligibility and other issues will only be entertained if the requested information is not given in the Information Bulletin.
- 1.6. Incomplete application, if not in accordance with instructions, will not be considered and is liable to be rejected. Applicant should carefully fill up all the fields during registration process. Application once submitted finally, cannot be withdrawn/modified.
- 1.7. The examination fee will not be refunded under any circumstances. Fee will neither be carried forward to a future exam nor refunded under any circumstances.
- 1.8. Instructions in the Information-Bulletin are liable to change based on decisions taken by the AIIA/MoA/ Constitutional Authorities.
- 1.9. AIIA/MoA reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted inadvertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in AIAPGET 2017 even though Admit card/Registration number has been issued or is displayed on website.
- 1.10. AIIA/MoA does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be purely provisional subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in

the Information Bulletin for AIAPGET 2017 & criteria of CCIM/CCH/ State/Universities/Institutions concerned.

- 1.11. Candidates must verify from the respective state governments/ Universities/ Deemed university & Institutes if at all they will be considered for admission to All India (Open/Other State) / State Quota Post Graduate seats/Institute Pool based on applicable Regulations and /or domicile criteria, State/Institute of Graduation, reservation policy etc. Merely appearing in AIAPGET 2017 does not make a candidate qualified and/or eligible for All India (Open/Other State)/ State Quota seats/admission to Universities / Deemed Universities & Institutions.
- 1.12. The existing schedule, pattern, policy and guidelines are for ready reference only but in no way, they are or are ought to be treated as representative or acknowledgment of fact that MoA/AIIA is bound to follow the same in future.
- 1.13. In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions/terms/rules/criteria regarding the determination of eligibility/conduct of examinations/registration of candidates/ information contained herein, the interpretation of the MoA/AIIA will be final and binding.
- 1.14. Requests shall not be entertained for change in date/examination centre. Candidates are advised not to canvass for or submit such representations.
- 1.15. Absentees from the examination will forfeit their examination fee. No further communication will be acknowledged in this regard.
- 1.16. Result for AIAPGET 2017 will be available on the website www.aiapget.com.
- 1.17. Candidates MUST bring the following documents to the test centre -
 - Printed copy of Admit Card with latest passport size photo pasted on it (will be retained by the centre); AND
 - Any one of the authorized photo IDs*(must be original, valid and non-expired): PAN card/Driving license/Voter ID/Passport/Aadhaar Card (with photograph). The candidate must bring the same photo identity proof as mentioned during the registration process.
 - Self-attested copy of authorized photo ID which will be retained by the center.

**The name on the photo identification must match with the name as shown on the Admit card. If the name has been changed due to events such as marriage, candidate must show the relevant document*

mentioned at the time of exam (Marriage Certificate/ Divorce/ Decree/Legal Name Change Document).

The examination test centre staff on duty is authorized to verify the identity of candidates and may take steps to verify and record the identity of candidates. Candidates are required to extend requisite cooperation.

Candidate reporting examination center without the above said requisite documents shall not be allowed for the examination.

- 1.18. Candidates should ensure before applying for online registration that their BAMS/BUMS/BSMS/BHMS degree is recognized as per provisions of IMCC/CCH Act. If it is found at any time that BAMS/BUMS/BSMS/BHMS degree is not recognized, the candidature/result of the candidate shall be cancelled/ deemed to be cancelled.
- 1.19. **All the correspondence should preferably be addressed by e-mail.** The e-mail query shall be addressed only if it is not anonymous and contains the name, postal address and contact number of the sender. An e-mail containing vague or general queries and other queries as contained in the Information Bulletin shall not be entertained. Queries shall not be entertained from person claiming themselves to be representative, associates or officiates of the applicant candidate. The following information shall not be revealed by phone or email:
- a. Internal documentation /status.
 - b. Internal decision-making process of MoA/AIIA, Any claim /counter claim thereof.
 - c. Dates & venue of internal meetings or name of the staff/officers dealing.
 - d. Any information which in the opinion of MoA/AIIA cannot be revealed.
- 1.20. Terms & Conditions of AIAPGET 2017 as mentioned in the english version of Information Bulletin shall apply.
- 1.21. AIAPGET 2017 will be conducted by MoA/AIIA at exam centers engaged for the purpose. Candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the route and location of the exam centre. (Refer Section 8 for list of exam cities)
- 1.22. Candidates are advised to look into website www.aiapget.com regularly for various information and notices pertaining to AIAPGET 2017 examination. No separate information will be published in newspaper.
- 1.23. A Demo test shall be available for the benefit of candidates to familiarize themselves with the Computer Based Test format at website www.aiapget.com. Applicants will be able to access the Demo test from

10th July 2017 upon entering their login ID (issued at the end of registration).

- 1.24. Kindly note that by registering for the AIAPGET 2017, candidates are covered by Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA). As per NDA, candidates cannot disclose any question or contents of question paper in part or otherwise with any person or party or website or such other media/publication. Any act in breach of the NDA shall be liable for penal action as per law, kindly note that this is a punishable offence and shall lead to cancellation of candidature at the bare threshold.
- 1.25. Candidates are deemed to have read, agreed and accepted the Information Bulletin and the terms and conditions in the information bulletin for AIAPGET 2017 on completing the registration/application form by the candidates.
- 1.26. Candidate can register in AIAPGET 2017 once only. Any candidate found to register more than once in AIAPGET 2017 will be automatically debarred from the exam. His/her candidature will be cancelled and further action as deemed appropriate by MoA/AIIA will be taken.
- 1.27. Possession/Use of mobile phone or any such electronic devices is strictly prohibited in the premises of AIAPGET 2017 test centers. Candidates shall be liable for penal action for Possession/ Use of Mobile phones/ Electronic devices.
- 1.28. The jurisdiction for court cases/disputes shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts at Delhi/New Delhi only.
